This mitigation plan focuses on BAVTS student and staff cases and less on community transmissions levels. Home COVID-19 tests are not reported in state or CDC case counting so are now less accurate measures of spread.

Guiding Metrics: BAVTS student/staff cases average 10-15 per day. No evidence of community spread in school(s). BAVTS will continue to communicate with the Bethlehem Health Bureau and health networks regarding additional metrics such as, transmission rates and hospitalizations. Additional mitigation strategies may be implemented if conditions warrant such steps.
